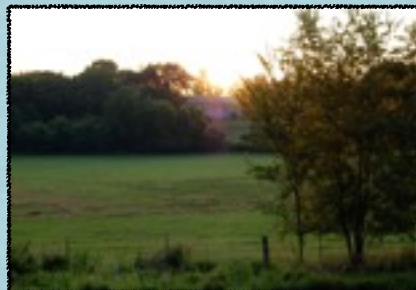
Excited For Another Year

SOME CHANGES FOR US THIS YEAR
